## Preparing for the future of EU fisheries

- Ensure that EU fishers have access to areas inside the EU and outside the EU
- Use EU market access in negotiations with Coastal States, Norway and the UK
- Address the issue of stakeholder consultation in the implementation of the Maritime Spatial Planning Directive (European Court of Auditor report on Offhsore Renewable Energy)
- Create positive incentives for green transition
- Secure legislative transparency, simplification and stability at both EU and national level.
- Secure legislative flexibility at all levels to allow for adaptation to climate change, spatial planning and 3.
   country agreements

## Preparing for the future of EU fisheries

« 21st century fishing must take place in 21st century vessels »

- Secure testing funds to ensure a risk-free testing environment for fishers
- Limit new taxes on fishing fuel as suggested in the revision of the Energy Taxation Directive until viable alternatives are market ready.

Centralise Fisheries' key role as a strategic sector for the European Commission

- Reform the Common Fisheries
   Policy to adapt to the new context (Energy transition, Brexit, climate change)
- Name an executive vice president in charge of food sovereignty inside the Commission
